



Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament

Adoration takes place Tuesdays after 8:30 AM Mass until 11 AM.

Communion Calls

Communion is normally distributed to the homebound on the Thursday morning before First Friday of each month, except by special arrangements.

Sacrament of Holy Baptism

Baptisms take place in the main Church in Ashland. They occur on Saturday Mornings. Prior to the day, parents must attend a class, and be regularly attending weekend Masses for at least three months. Pre-register for this class with the Parish Office.

Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick

Please call the Parish Office to make arrangements.

Sacrament of Holy Matrimony

At least six months before a couple hopes to get married, he and she must talk face to face with the priest and get a firm wedding date and time from him. Only after this initial contact should a couple set the dates for a reception or a honeymoon.


